### Women Empowerment:

Women empowerment one of the major activities of the organization. Jharkhand Mahila Jagriti has been formed the 300 women Self Help Group in the Sadar, Daru, Vishnugarh and Tatijahriya blocks of Hazaribagh. Total 3200 women are member of the SHG. These SHGs members area not only doing the economic activities but also engage in the social activities. Then group women destroyed the Desi Sarab Bhatthi (illegal liquor making unit) at village Silwar of Sadar Block of Hazaribagh district in which more than 500 men and women protested. The group members also resolved the family disputes and raise the voice against the domestic violence.



The organization organized the training program for these women like account training , leadership training, livelihood, skills development etc. The organization promotes the women for participation in the Panchayat and raises the women issues in the panchayat.

**Livelihood Promotion Program:** Jharkhand Mahila Jagriti wants to promote the livelihood activities among the women. The organization organized many training programs for SHG group women. Under the livelihood promotion program, we organized the training on mushroom production, Increase Sticks, Sewing and stitching training, Goat rearing etc. More than 400 women are trained on different trades and they are engaged in income generating activities.

**Adolescents Health Fair (Anandi Mela):** Health is Wealth. JMJ is also working for the adolescents group for delay the early marriage among the adolescents and promote the health awareness among the adolescents girls. We organized the health awareness program and more than 300 adolescents were trained on adolescent's health under the Anandi Mela the girls were informed about the importance of delaying the marriage and health issues including the physical changes in body. JMJ organized the adolescents fair by the help of BREAKTHROUGH organization in which more than 300 people including the adolescent girls and women participated in the program. The nuked team performed the cultural program and gave the message for delay the child marriage. The panchayat representatives also participated in program and assured to stop the child marriage in their area.

**Agriculture Promotion Program:** JMJ promote the women formers for sustainable agriculture. The organization organized the training program for vegetable growing and sells into the market. Approx. 200 farmers of Daru block benefited from the program and increased the family income. The organization informed about the HYV seeds and new technique of farming including the SRI- Systematic Rice Intensification. The farmers increased the double production of paddy last year.

**Health Awareness program:** JMJ organized the health awareness program among the women about the Reproductive and child health camp at village level. Health checkup of adolescents and distribution of folic acid tablets among the girls. The organization call the ANM and doctors in the program and inform about the preventive measure related the health issues. We cover the ANC, PNC, UTI, STI, HIV/AIDS, etc. Approx. 1500 people were informed about the HIV/AIDS.

**Sewing- Embroidery training:** There is no shortage of skills in rural areas, there is a need to improve them with the main stream of the Society. With this effort, rural economy can be strengthened by providing employment to rural youth and women.

### **Malnutrition-free society:**

In the financial year 2019-2020, a one-day seminar on the challenges of nutrition and Building a malnutrition-free society was organized by the organization on 30 September 2019



at Jhar Craft Hazaribagh . Women participated in the seminar. 5 nutrition tips were discussed. It was told about nutritious diet, attention to cleanliness and blue iron tablet should be taken by teenager girl and children from 6 months to 59 months should be given 1 ml iron syrup twice a week. Anaemia, diarrhoea and malnutrition free society can be built by keeping nutritious diet, cleanliness.

### **Capacity building training of SHG group**

One day workshop organise by NABARD. A one day workshop focused on women and support group promotion financial inclusion and entrepreneurship promotion among them was organised by NGO

Jharkhand Mahila Jagriti under the leadership of District Development manager Prem Prakash Singh at shinghani Panchayat Bhavan courtesy of NABARD.

About 75 Women from 20 different groups took advantage of this workshop. District Development Manager NABARD Prem Prakash Singh took a session on the element of group operation with small Savings bank loans and lively hood training among the women in which all the grand NABARD for promotion of entrepreneurship like small dairy, poultry He also gave detailed information on the subject provision of rearing, goat and pig farming agriclinic center and agricultural marketing.

**Celebration of International Women's Day:** Every year Jharkhand Mahila Jagriti celebrates the international Women's Day at Amritnagar on 8<sup>th</sup> March. We call women of SHG in one place and give opportunity to share their women related issues. We are talking about the women empowerment. Same day we organize the game for women. We motivate the women for raise the voice against any type of violence. We inform the women about the legal Act and helpline. The group women share their experiences. More than 500 women accumulate in one place and whole day celebrate the program. We call the CDPO, BDO, other government officers, PRI preventatives in the program. They address the women and motivate for come out and take responsibility. No one can be illiterate and focus on the education of girl child.

**Celebration of National Day:** We organize the independence and republic day in our office. Our staffs and local community comes in program. We call the local leader and host the flag. We also keep some cultural program and game for girls on same day. Most of participants in program are women and girls. The participants are informing about the social evils and oath to not bear the violence and strengthen the voice. We all wants to develop the violence free society and every people get the equal opportunity in their livelihood and live peaceful life free from any fear.
